These rules and guidelines comply with Data Protection and the requirements of the Information Commissioner, enabling the scheme to share information with the signed up members and Scheme Partners of the Business Crime Reduction Partnership.

CGBW is a non-profit making limited company, and is funded primarily by membership annual subscriptions.

CGBW has professional indemnity insurance, to protect the scheme and it's members.

The CGBW Board of Management consists of key scheme partners representatives from the Shopwatch and Pubwatch members. The local MP is a member of the Board of Management and an active Patron of the scheme.

CGBW empowers the local businesses to work in close partnership with each other and various organisations such as Sussex Police, WSFRS, Crawley Borough Council, Town Centre Partnership, CRI, Addaction Probation, Crawley Open House, Trading Standards and many more.

**Pubwatch** is not just about excluding those involved in a brawl on a Friday night, it's about all businesses linked to the evening economy working together - pubs, clubs, hotels, restaurants, take-aways, private hires etc. to ensure we have a well run and thriving evening economy

Anyone who is issued a warning or exclusion will know how to identify easily which premises are members, if a person is banned on **Shopwatch** it is from ALL **Shopwatch** premises, similarly if a person is placed on **Pubwatch** they are Banned from ALL **Pubwatch** members. The impact of this is that a banned person has to look at travelling further to do their shopping or going out for a night out.

For a vulnerable person in the community or someone who has been a victim as a result of someone who is excluded, the logo represents a place of safety.
